## THINGS TO KNOW

### JUDGES:

The artwork will be judged by the EWOC Planning Committee on correspondence to the theme, artistic merit, and transferability to a t-shirt, poster & tote bag

### AWARDS:

\$200 to each of the top 3 designs

### WHAT KIND OF ARTWORK TO ENTER:

2 dimensional paintings, drawings, mixed media using the EARTH TONE color palate

### DIVISIONS:

Artists must enter their work in one of the following divisions:

- Youth—ages 17 & under
- Young Adult—ages 18-49
- Older Adult—ages 50 & up

## THEME:

### INTERGENERATIONAL WISDOM: CELEBRATING OUR PAST, PRESENT & FUTURE

This year, the conference will honor the legacy of women of color worldwide, celebrate the struggles of women of all ages, and provides a space for growth, empowerment, and practical tools for everyday life. The nation's oldest and largest women of color conference will focus on embracing our collective histories, acknowledging our impact on the present, and supporting our lifelong development across generations. The two-day conference will be dedicated to issues affecting women at every stage of their lives with workshops, speakers, panels, performances, networking, and vendors of interest to all age groups.

**LEGAL CONDITIONS:** By entering this competition, you agree to the following entry rules:

By entering the contest, participants agree to allow your entered artwork to be published on the EWOC website, and used for promotions of EWOC including, but not limited to, publications from EWOC and other organizations, exhibitions, posters, flyers, t-shirts, tote bags, and web pages and emails providing EWOC information and updates.

By entering, participants warrant that his or her entry materials are original, do not infringe on any third party's rights, and that participant has obtained any necessary permissions from any third party if a third party or third party's property appears in the photograph. EWOC reserves the right to disqualify any entry if it finds in its sole discretion that any of the foregoing warranties are not true. Decisions of EWOC shall be final and binding.

By entering, participants release and hold harmless EWOC, its affiliated organizations, and each of their directors, officers, employees, attorneys, agents and representatives (collectively, the "Companies") from any and all liability for any injuries, loss, claim, action, demand or damage of any kind arising from or related to the EWOC, any prize won, any use of the entry materials by EWOC, the warranties participants make, any misuse or malfunction of any prize awarded, participation in any EWOC-related activity, or participation in the EWOC.

The contest is governed by the laws of the United States and is subject to applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Participant agrees that any and all disputes that cannot be resolved with the Companies, and causes of action arising out of or connected with the EWOC, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action.
